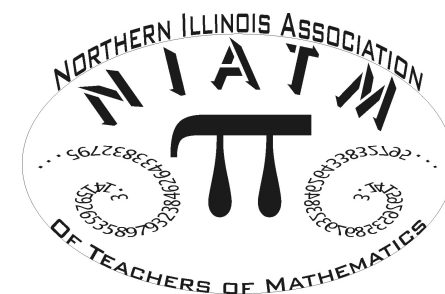

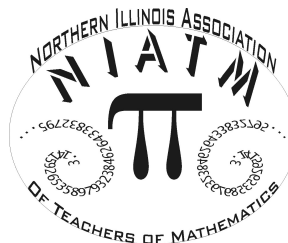

“Teaching by Walking Around”

Presenter: John Benson

John shares some of his teaching strategies used during his 42 year high school career. During the presentation, he will model some of the practices he used in the classroom, so come prepared to be an active participant.

Benson retired from full time teaching at Evanston Township High School in 2010, and is currently employed as a full-time consultant by The Center for Elementary Mathematics and Science Education at The University of Chicago. Over his career, he has also taught in Georgia and presented summer programs for teachers in Iowa and Illinois. He has co-authored Algebra 1, Algebra 2 with Trig and Integrated Algebra/Geometry textbooks and has had articles published in numerous mathematics publications. He has presented at over 300 conferences and workshops and is the recipient of numerous honors and awards in mathematics education.
